Pets in parks shall be kept on a leash of 8' or less in length, and be in control of a responsible person.

Pets are prohibited in the Open Space area during the National Cherry Festival.

Pets are also prohibited from designated swimming areas and City beaches, or the portions thereof that are mechanically groomed.

Additionally, pets are prohibited in the Farmers' Market Area during its hours of operation.



Beer and wine are the ONLY alcoholic beverages allowed in City Parks, with the following exceptions:


Beer and wine are not allowed in American Legion Park, Clinch Park Beach, F & M Park, Hannah Park, Hickory Hills, J. Smith Walkway and Lay Park.

Glass containers of any kind, regardless of contents, are prohibited within any water area or land area used as a swimming or bathing beach area.




Smoking is prohibited in City Parks as follows:

- All park buildings and shelters
- All designated swimming areas
- All mechanically groomed beach areas
- Within 15 feet of a playground area
- Waterfront parks which are so posted
