200 Block S. Cass St. Closure

S. Cass St. will be closed September 2nd through September 6th, 2019

TRAVERSE CITY- Motorists and pedestrians should be aware that Quality Excavating will be closing the 200 Block of S. Cass St. between E. State St. and the Alley to the South for utility work. This work will cause closures and disruptions to pedestrian and vehicular traffic. This closure will take place on Monday August 5th, 2019 at 7:00 a.m. and will re-open by 9:00 p.m. on Tuesday August 6th, 2019. This will cause disruptions to pedestrian and vehicle traffic. The work is weather dependent. The Alley to the South will remain open at all times. S. Cass St. between E. State St. and the Alley to the South will be impacted.

Appropriate signage will be in place and access to all businesses and residences will be maintained at all times.
