The upper stretches of the “new” river at Brown Bridge need your help!

This area was dredged to re-locate the original channel lost under tons of sediment that accumulated over the 90 years Brown Bridge dam was in place. This sediment also covered the native seed bank far below. We are looking for volunteers to assist with planting over 3,000 native tree and shrub seedlings to help



reestablish a healthy riparian corridor and stabilize the banks of the river. This opportunity is open to anyone capable of working by foot on soft and uneven terrain.
