

IN THE JAY SMITH WALKWAY**

- Because,** Traverse City Code of Ordinances Section 1064.09 provides that no person may possess any alcoholic beverage, other than beer and wine in any city park, and that the City Commission may, by resolution, ban the consumption and possession of beer and wine in any park or designated portion of a park; and
- Because,** the City Commission has determined it to be in the best interest of the public health, safety and welfare, to ban the possession and consumption of beer and wine in The Jay Smith Walkway; now therefore be it,
- Resolved,** that as provided by Traverse City Code of Ordinances, Section 1064.09, the possession and consumption of beer and wine is prohibited in the Jay Smith Walkway as outlined in Attachment A; further be it
- Resolved,** that notice of the ban of all alcoholic beverages in The Jay Smith Walkway shall be posted at such points within or at the perimeter of the area where the ban is in effect as the City Manager shall direct.

AT HICKORY HILLS**

WHEREAS, the City of Traverse City has received complaints regarding alcoholic consumption and littering in the disc golf course area at Hickory Hills; and


WHEREAS, Traverse City Parks and Recreation staff have confirmed that alcoholic containers and other types of litter have been found in this area; and

WHEREAS, the City of Traverse City and the Northern Michigan Disc Sports Association agree that a ban on alcoholic beverages at Hickory Hills is in the best interest of the community; now therefore be it

RESOLVED, that pursuant to the Traverse City Code of Ordinances, Section 1064.09, the consumption and possession of all alcoholic beverages, including beer and wine, shall not be allowed at Hickory Hills; and

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the ban of all alcoholic beverages at Hickory Hills shall be posted on signs at points within and/or at the perimeter of Hickory Hills.

RESOLUTION BANNING THE POSSESSION AND CONSUMPTION OF
ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES
AT CLINCH PARK BEACH

- Because, Traverse City Code of Ordinances Section 1064.09 provides that no person may possess any alcoholic beverage, other than beer and wine in any City park, and that the City Commission may, by resolution, ban the consumption and possession of beer and wine in any park or designated portion of a park; and
- Because, the City commission has determined it to be in the best interest of the public health, safety and welfare, to ban the possession and consumption of beer and wine at Clinch Park Beach; and
- Because, Clinch Park Beach shall be designated as that land bordered by West Grand Traverse Bay on the north, Grandview Parkway on the south, Murchie Bridge on the east, and the western edge of the beach sand on the west; now therefore be it,
- Resolved, that as provided by Traverse City Code of Ordinances, Section 1064.09, the possession and consumption of beer and wine is prohibited at Clinch Park Beach; further be it
- Resolved, that notice of the ban of all alcoholic beverages at Clinch Park Beach shall be posted at such points within or at the perimeter of the area where the ban is in effect as the City Manager shall direct.

F & M PARK

WHEREAS, Boardman Neighborhood has requested that alcohol be prohibited in F & M Park due to the extensive use of the Park by children and due to the very local nature of the park; and


WHEREAS, the City Commission has discussed this matter and concurs with the Neighborhood; and

WHEREAS, F & M Park shall be designated as that land bordered by State Street on the north, Railroad Avenue on the west, Hope Street on the east, and Washington Street on the south; and

WHEREAS, in conformance with Chapter 10, Section 10.01(9) of the Traverse City Code of Ordinance, Park Rules and Regulations, the City Commission may ban the consumption and possession of all alcoholic beverages, including beer and wine, within any park or designated portion of the park;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Commission hereby bans the consumption or possession of all alcoholic beverages, including beer and wine, within F & M Park as above designated effective May 13, 1986.
