

POLICY FOR RESIDENTIAL LIGHTING

- 1) The City Commission shall accept petitions from property owners to establish a residential lighting district, under the same conditions as all other petitions for special assessments.
- 2) In order to consider a special assessment for residential lighting, the petition must call for the installation of lights on both sides of an entire block.
- 3) The choice of lighting styles is to be determined in conjunction with the petitioners, Director of Light and Power and the City Manager. Lighting styles must be consistent throughout the entire neighborhood.
- 4) Once the petition is received, the normal special assessment process shall be followed.
- 5) The City Commission shall pay 20% of the cost of the special assessment. Property owners shall pay 80% of the cost of the special assessment.
- 6) The period of the special assessment shall not exceed 10 years.
- 7) The City shall pay all operation and maintenance costs for the new lighting system.
