## Charitable Contributions

Regarding contributions or gifts, the City maintains that the Internal Revenue Code section 170(c) applies. That section reads as follows: "For purposes of this section, the term "charitable contribution" means a contribution or gift to or for the use of a state, a possession of the United States, or any political subdivision of any of the foregoing or the United States or the District of Columbia, but only if the contribution or gift is made for exclusively public purposes."

Therefore, the City of Traverse City construes this to mean that a contribution or gift to the City of Traverse City would be a charitable contribution if it is made for exclusively public purposes. We suggest you contact a professional accountant to determine if this applies to you in whole or in part.
