TRAVERSE CITY PLANNING COMMISSION PUBLIC HEARINGS

Please take notice that the Traverse City Planning Commission has scheduled Public Hearings for 6:00 p.m. on **Tuesday, May 5, 2026**, in the Commission Chambers on the second floor of the Governmental Center, 400 Boardman Avenue, Traverse City, Michigan, to consider the following:

A proposal to amend Chapter 1328 - OS – Open Space District, to add “Municipal Markets” to the uses allowed, and;

A proposal to modify chapters 1342 - C-2 Neighborhood Center District, 1344 - C-3 Community Center District, and 1347 - Development Districts to require special land use approval for all autocentric land uses, including car washes, drive throughs, and service/fuel stations. And further, to amend chapter 1364 - Special Land Use Regulations to consolidate all special land use standards.
