SUBJECT: Milliken Drive, near Milliken Court, Crossing Pedestrian Count Study

City Engineering conducted an hour long study between 2:56–3:56 on May 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2018 at the intersection Milliken Drive, near Milliken Court. City Engineering observed a total of 10 pedestrians using the intersection over this time-period. Of these 10 pedestrians, all of them traveled on an East-West path. Of the pedestrians that crossed this intersection, none of the pedestrians waited at the intersection for traffic to clear. It should be further noted that pedestrian crossing signs are posted and a crosswalk is painted on the road. Additionally, ADT=2883, and the intersection in question does also fall on the edge of Traverse City Central High School. Thus, the Pedestrian Crossing Treatment Installation Guidelines indicates “No action” for this particular situation. This observation was conducted on a clear, sunny day (67° F), during a regular school week.
