Randolph Street Lane Closure

TRAVERSE CITY- Motorists and pedestrians should be aware that the Traverse City Street Department will be starting a paving project on Randolph Street, from Madison Street to just West of Fulton Street. At times, the street will be down to one lane with flaggers present to direct traffic. The lane closure will take place Monday August 31st, 2020 to Thursday September 3rd, 2020. The work is weather dependent.

Appropriate signage will be in place and access to all businesses and residences will be maintained at all times.

If possible, please use alternate routes avoiding this area to reduce congestion, delay, and promote worker safety.
