Sixth Street Closure from Division Street to Spruce Street 9/20/21

Sixth St. will be closed September 20, 2021

TRAVERSE CITY- Motorists and pedestrians should be aware that Elmer's Crane and Dozer, Inc. will be closing Sixth Street between Division St. and Spruce St. for the installation of the third and final culvert for the Kids Creek Culvert Project. This work will cause closures and disruptions to vehicular traffic. This closure will take place Wednesday, September 20th, at 7:00 a.m. and will reopen approximately Friday, November 5th, at 7 p.m.

The City of Traverse City and the Watershed Center Grand Traverse Bay have recently awarded a project to Elmer's Crane and Dozer Inc. known as the Kids Creek Crossing Project. The project consists of improving 3 road crossings and underground utilities. There are two culvert locations on Cedar Street and one on Sixth Street. This will cause disruptions to vehicle traffic. The work is weather dependent. Appropriate signage will be in place and access to all residences will be maintained at all times.

Please use alternate routes avoiding this area to reduce congestion, delay, and inconvenience for your travels.
