## **S. Garfield Ave. Detour September 15<sup>th</sup> – September 17, 2021**

TRAVERSE CITY- The City of Traverse City and Elmer's Crane and Dozer will be constructing a pedestrian refuge island in S. Garfield Ave. at the Washington St. intersection.

The work is expected to start September 15<sup>th</sup> and be substantially complete by September 17, 2021.

**Northbound S. Garfield Ave. traffic will be detoured at E. Eighth St. to Fair St. then west on US-31. Southbound S. Garfield Ave. traffic will be maintained.**

Please use caution in and around the work zones to promote pedestrian and worker safety. Appropriate signage and barricades will be in place.
