The City of Traverse City is developing its Annual Action Plan for Program Year (PY) **2026-27 from July 1, 2026 to June 30, 2027** for HUD Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funding. The city expects to receive approximately \$370,400 in CDBG funds for PY 2026-2027.

The City Commission will hold two public hearings on the draft **PY 2026-27 Annual Action Plan** and will have an open comment period running from **April 6, 2026 through May 11, 2026**. Comments from the public are welcome throughout this time span, or during the two public hearings.

The first of two public hearings on the PY 2026-27 Annual Action Plan will take place on **April 6, 2026 at 7:00 pm**. The second public hearing will take place on **May 11, 2026 at 7:00 pm**. Both public hearings will be held during City Commission Meetings held at the Governmental Center located at 400 Boardman Ave, Traverse City, MI 49684.
