

## **REQUEST FOR NEW WATER SERVICE**

#### **Instructions**

This form should be completed if you are applying to:

- Install a new water meter at an existing address or new location (within Traverse City city limits)
- Change the size of your existing water meter as a Traverse City Water Customer
- Have water access on a job site using a temporary water meter

If a new tap on a Traverse City Water Main is required, please see instructions located on the Water Tap Application, available on our website (<u>https://www.traversecitymi.gov/government/city-departments/sewer-and-water/</u>)

#### Project Checklist for New Service:

- 1. **SUBMIT REQUIRED FORM(S)**. Please fill out and submit this form for any new water service. Additionally, a Water Tap Application is required for any new water taps.
  - The service address listed on this form MUST MATCH official address according to Traverse City Assessing; water meter(s) will not be installed if address and/or unit numbers are labeled incorrectly

- METER BASE INSTALLATION. Meter Setters ("Copperhorns") are provided by Traverse City Water & Sewer Maintenance as part of the meter package cost. They can be picked up from our shop located at 604 Hannah Ave during our business hours (M-F, 7:00AM-3:00PM).
  - The contractor is responsible for installing the meter base and running meter wire from the water meter to an exterior wall on the building, per city ordinance 1044.09 (g)
- 3. **SCHEDULE METER INSTALL.** Once the first two steps above are complete, please call Traverse City Water & Sewer Maintenance at (231) 922-4923, option 2, to schedule the meter install.
