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**Union Street Closure from Front Street to State Street
*August 17, 2026***

Traverse City, Mich. — Motorists, bicyclists, and pedestrians should be aware that the Traverse City Department of Mobility Infrastructure will conduct asphalt surface repairs on Union Street in preparation for the upcoming cape seal project.

Work will be completed on one half of the roadway at a time, allowing Union Street to remain open to traffic in one direction throughout the project. Sidewalks will remain open.

Work is scheduled to begin Monday, August 17, 2026. Union Street will initially be closed to southbound traffic, while northbound traffic will remain open. Once work on that half of the roadway is complete, crews will switch sides, closing Union Street to northbound traffic while reopening the roadway to southbound traffic. The project is expected to be completed by the end of the day on Wednesday, August 19, 2026.

This work may cause disruptions to pedestrian, bicycle, and vehicular traffic. Appropriate signage will be in place, and access to all homes and businesses will be maintained at all times.

If possible, please use alternate routes avoiding this area to reduce congestion, delay, and promote worker safety.
