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**Seventh Street Closure between Oak Street and Maple Street
*September 21, 2026***

Traverse City, Mich. — Motorists, bicyclists, and pedestrians should be aware that the Traverse City Department of Mobility Infrastructure will be closing Seventh Street between Oak Street and Maple Street for a mill and pave project. Work is expected to begin Monday, September 21, 2026, and be completed by 3:00 p.m. on Friday, September 25, 2026.

All sidewalks will remain open throughout the project. Motorists and bicyclists should expect temporary traffic disruptions and are encouraged to use alternate routes. Appropriate signage and traffic control measures will be in place. Access to all homes and businesses within the project area will be maintained at all times via the alleys.

Properties owners and residents who will have limited access to their driveways are permitted to park on S Oak or S Maple streets for the duration of the project. Access includes exceeding signed timed parking limits and overnight parking for the duration of the project.
