## TRAFFIC CONTROL ORDER NO. 183

A traffic signal light shall be installed at the following intersection:

"TRAFFIC SIGNAL LIGHT shall be installed at the intersection of Parsons Road & Hastings Street on a "stop" and "go" basis. This signal shall revert to "flasher" at times when volume or traffic movement does not require fully controlled operation. During "flasher" operations, Parsons Road shall be a "thru street" on the caution signal and traffic on Hastings Street shall be required to "stop" on red. A sign shall also be installed at this intersection to permit only right and left turns onto Parsons Road for all northbound Hastings traffic.
