W. Front Street Lane Flagging
West Front Street Safety Enhancement Project

Traverse City – Motorists, bicyclists, and pedestrians should be aware that the City’s contractor will begin the W. Front Street Safety Enhancement project between Madison Street and the City limits on Monday, September 29, 2025. The project is anticipated to be completed on Friday, October 3, 2025, weather permitting

Intermittent flag control will be in effect during work activities on September 30 and October 1, 2025. Pavement marking is scheduled for October 2, 2025. This work will be conducted as a mobile operation.

Work activities include installing advisory signage and pavement markings to improve safety at the horizontal curve and the guardrail on the north side of the street. These signs and markings are intended to alert drivers and passengers that they are entering a curve with a posted speed limit of 25 mph, helping to protect both roadway users and adjacent property owners. The guardrail is designed to redirect vehicles that leave the roadway, providing additional protection along the roadside.

This work will generate dust and noise, and may cause disruptions to pedestrian, bicycle, and vehicular traffic with intermittent closures of sidewalks and streets. Appropriate signage will be in place, and access to all homes and businesses will be maintained at all times. If possible, please use alternate routes avoiding this area to reduce congestion, delay, and promote worker safety.
