Cass & Eighth Intersection Closure
Traffic Signal Work

Traverse City – Motorists, bicyclists, and pedestrians should be aware that the City of Traverse City’s contractor will continue with repairs on the traffic signal at Cass and Eighth Street.

Work activities to repair the light will start at 8:00 am on Thursday, September 4, 2025 and will result in a closure of the Cass and Eighth Street intersection. The work is anticipated to be completed by the end of day on September 4, 2025.

Currently, the traffic signal is blinking red and should be treated as a four-way stop.

This work may cause disruptions to pedestrian, bicycle, and vehicular traffic. Appropriate signage will be in place, and access to all homes and businesses will be maintained at all times.

If possible, please use alternate routes avoiding this area to reduce congestion, delay, and promote worker safety.
