**Cape Seal Project Preparation Locations**  
*Week of August 4, 2025*

Traverse City – Motorists, bicyclists, and pedestrians should be aware that the Traverse City Streets Division will be conducting asphalt surface repairs in preparation for the City’s Cape Seal project.

The week of August 4th, the following streets (in work order) will have intermittent closures and/or lane shifts.

- Locust St (10th St to 14th St): Lane Shifts
- Cedar St (2nd St to Randolph St): Lane Shifts

This work may cause disruptions to pedestrian, bicycle, and vehicular traffic. Appropriate signage will be in place, and access to all homes and businesses will be maintained at all times. If possible, please use alternate routes avoiding this area to reduce congestion, delay, and promote worker safety.
