

## City of Traverse City Street Use Permit – Non-Major Event

Pursuant to Section 1020.05 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Traverse City, Michigan, the following streets are hereby permitted to be utilized as outlined in the attached application on:

Saturday, January 18, 2025 from 8:30am – 11:30am

Streets: Eastern Ave, East Shore Dr, Timberlane Dr, Huron Hills Dr, Quail Ridge Dr, East Bay Blvd, East Front St, Huron St, Chippewa St

**Event Name: Frozen Foot Race** 

Event Organizer: TC Track Club (Jason Whittaker applicant)

Shall have use and supervisory authority over said streets on the date and during the time period above indicated subject to the following terms and conditions:

- 1. The applicant shall furnish to the City Clerk's office a Certificate of Insurance for Comprehensive General Liability in the amount of \$1 million per occurrence naming the City of Traverse City as additional insured. If alcohol is being served, the applicant shall furnish to the City Clerk's office a Certificate of Insurance for liquor liability in the amount of \$1 million per occurrence naming the City of Traverse City as additional insured.
- 2. The applicant shall be liable for all damages both to property and person and shall defend, indemnify and hold harmless the City, its officers, agents, and employees from any and all claims, liabilities, losses, damages, actual attorney fees, and settlement expenses resulting or arising out of or in connection with the performance of the act for which this permit is issued. The obligations to defend, indemnify and hold harmless shall exclude only those matters in which the claim arises out of allegations of the sole

negligence or act of the City, its officers, agents or employees.

- 3. The applicant shall reimburse the City for expenses such as police, fire, streets, and others as agreed upon between the City and the applicant and will be billed accordingly.
- 4. The applicant shall maintain a 20' wide center lane (10' on both sides of the center line) for emergency vehicles.
- 5. The application is attached hereto and made a part of this permit. In the event that any term, clause or provision of this Permit conflicts with any term, clause or provision contained in any attachments hereto, this Permit's terms shall prevail.
- 6. The applicant is responsible for any cleanup following this event and any damage done to City property and will be billed accordingly.
- 7. The applicant shall provide watchmen and flagmen as may be necessary for the safety and convenience of the public and shall furnish all barricades, signs and lights necessary to protect the public and/or such additional barricades, signs and lights as required per part VI of the current Michigan Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MMUTCD).
- 8. The rights granted by this permit are revocable at the will of the City of Traverse City, and the applicant waives any right to claim damages or compensation in the event that this permit is revoked.
- 9. The tent/canopy membrane material shall be on-combustible, flame resistant or treated in an approved manner in accordance with the State Building Code. On-site inspection may be required by the Fire Marshal; it is the responsibility of the Permit Holder to arrange such inspection at least seven days prior to the event.
- 10. This permit may not be transferred or assigned.

Permit Application Narrative

#### **Event Overview:**

We are requesting a permit to hold the Traverse City Track Club Frozen Foot Race, a competitive 5 Mile event aimed at promoting health, fitness, wellness, and a kick-off for our 2025 membership. The walk/run will be held on January 18th, 2025, from 9:30am to approximately 11:30am with participants of all ages and fitness levels. This event has been held since the mid-80's.

This family-friendly event is expected to attract approximately 250 walkers and runners, along with volunteers. Proceeds from the event will benefit the Traverse City Track Club Golden Shoe Fund and local scholarships.

Registration, awards, food, beverage, garbage bins, and bathrooms are all hosted in Eastern Elementary School.

The event is free to club members of the Traverse City Track Club and \$30 for all other participants. Children 12 & under are free and 13-17 is \$10.

#### **Event Route:**

The event will be staged at Eastern Elementary School. All the registration & post-race activities will be held at Eastern Elementary School, 1600 Eastern Ave. The 5 Mile will begin at 9:30am, with a kid's 1-mile fun run beginning at 9am. The run will head east on Eastern Ave, Left on East Shore Dr, Left onto Timberlane Dr, Left on Huron Hills Dr – Which turns into Quail Ridge Dr, Left on Eastern Ave, Right on East Bay BLVD, Road curves into E. Front St, Left on Huron St, Left on Chippewa St, Left on East Bay BLVD, Right on E. Front St that curves into Easy Bay BLVD, Left on Eastern Ave, and a left turn into Eastern Elementary School (Please see attached maps)

### **Safety and Logistics:**

No roads will be blocked or closed. To ensure the safety of participants, volunteers, and spectators, we will have a detailed safety plan that includes:

- Course Marshals: Volunteers will be stationed at key intersections and turns to guide participants and ensure safe crossings.

#### Clean-Up Plan:

Our team of volunteers will be responsible for cleaning the racecourse immediately following the event. This will include picking up trash, removing signage, and ensuring that all public spaces are returned to their original condition.
