Eighth Street Lane Flagging
Water Service Line Replacement Project

Traverse City – Motorists, bicyclists, and pedestrians should be aware Team Elmer's, in coordination with the City of Traverse City Water/Wastewater Maintenance Division, will conduct replacement of private galvanized water lines on Eighth Street between Union Street and Boardman Avenue beginning Thursday, September 11, 2025 through Tuesday, September 16, 2025.

Eighth Street between Union Street and Boardman Avenue will have intermittent flag control in effect during work activities. The work will cause intermittent sidewalk closures on the south side of the 200 block of Eighth Street.

This work will generate dust and noise, and may cause disruptions to pedestrian, bicycle, and vehicular traffic with intermittent closures of sidewalks and streets. Appropriate signage will be in place, and access to all homes and businesses will be maintained at all times. If possible, please use alternate routes avoiding this area to reduce congestion, delay, and promote worker safety.
