2026 Monroe Street Reconstruction Project Update
Phase 2 - Monroe Street from Randolph Street to Wayne Street

Traverse City – Motorists, bicyclists, and pedestrians should be aware that Phase 2 of the Monroe Street Reconstruction Project will begin on Monday, June 8, 2026. Monroe Street between Randolph Street to Wayne Street will close for reconstruction and is anticipated to be substantially completed on Friday, August 24, 2026.

The intersections of Monroe Street and Wayne Street and Monroe Street and Randolph Street will have intermittent construction during this timeline. Drivers should expect temporary lane shifts, lane closures, and street segment closures while work is being performed.

Phase 1 of the Monroe Street Reconstruction Project, between Front and Bay Street, is anticipated to be substantially completed in early July 2026.

Phase 3 of the project between Randolph and Front Street is anticipated to begin in summer 2026 with a completed date of Friday, October 30, 2026.

This work will include sanitary sewer, water main, storm sewer, curb and gutter, asphalt pavement, sidewalks, and all related improvements.

Access to all residences will be maintained, and appropriate signage will be in place. Work is weather dependent and modifications may be necessary. If possible, please use alternate routes avoiding this area to reduce congestion, delay, and promote worker safety.
