
TRAFFIC CONTROL ORDER NO. 105

Due to the removal of the traffic signal lights and the construction of an island for improved traffic movements at the intersection of Boardman Avenue & State Street, the following signs, regulating traffic, shall be installed at the following designated places:

"STOP" sign on the northeast corner of State Street requiring westbound traffic on State Street to "STOP" before proceeding north to Front St.

"STOP" sign on the southeast corner of Boardman Avenue requiring northbound traffic on Boardman Avenue to "STOP" at State Street.

"NO LEFT TURN" sign on the island to prohibit State Street traffic, coming from the east, to make a left-turn to go south on Boardman Ave.
